Since the last issue of AISHE-J was published we- have said goodbye to deeply valued colleague and friend, Dr Brett Becker. Brett passed away suddenly in October 2024. He joined the AISHE-J editorial team as Technical Editor in 2013 and played a key role in shaping the journal. Brett gave generously of his time and expertise to enhance learning and teaching nationally and internationally.
